BACKGROUND

Satellite communications seem to be awakening after a long period in which their only role appeared to be TV broadcasters, especially in Europe. Modern satellites start to deliver attractive broadband access performances by offering ever decreasing costs-per-bit and are becoming an important tool to overcome the digital divide. Current satellite services allow the access to mobile networks deployed in remote areas by granting connectivity to base stations but also complete terrestrial mobile networks by granting near-100% coverage in recent LTE deployments in the US.

This seminar will gather representatives from a number of key players in the field of satellite communications and mobility, who will provide their views on the role that satellites are bound to play in the new European mobile services in the coming years. A final panel will allow for an exchange of views among the companies and the participation of the audience.

This seminar is one of the activities organized within the project LIFTGATE, funded by the European Commission through the Seventh Framework Programme - Capactities.
